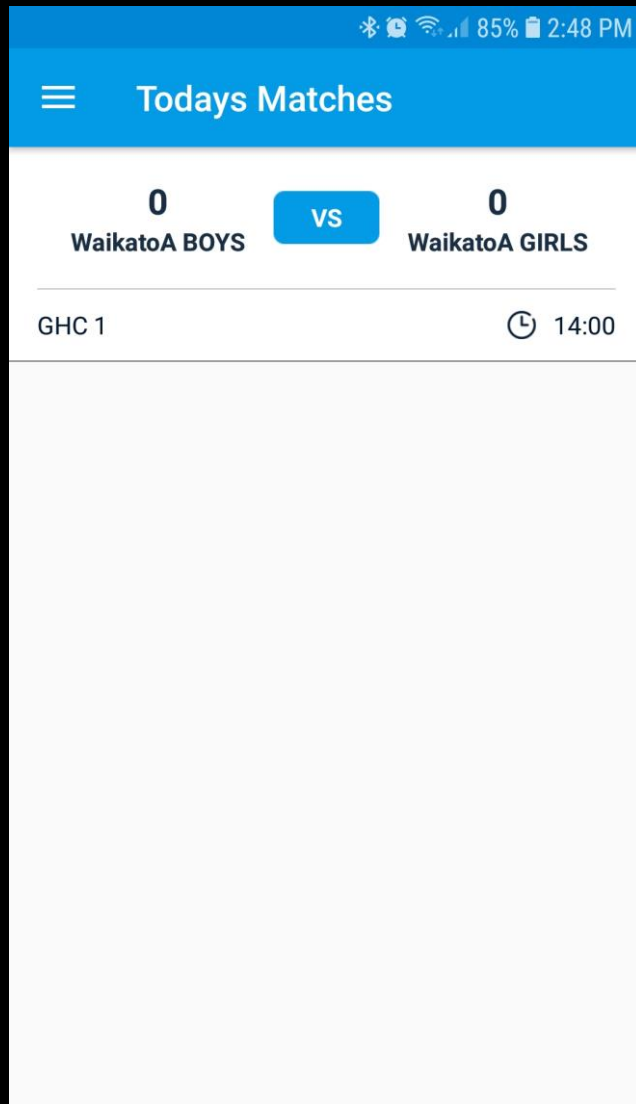

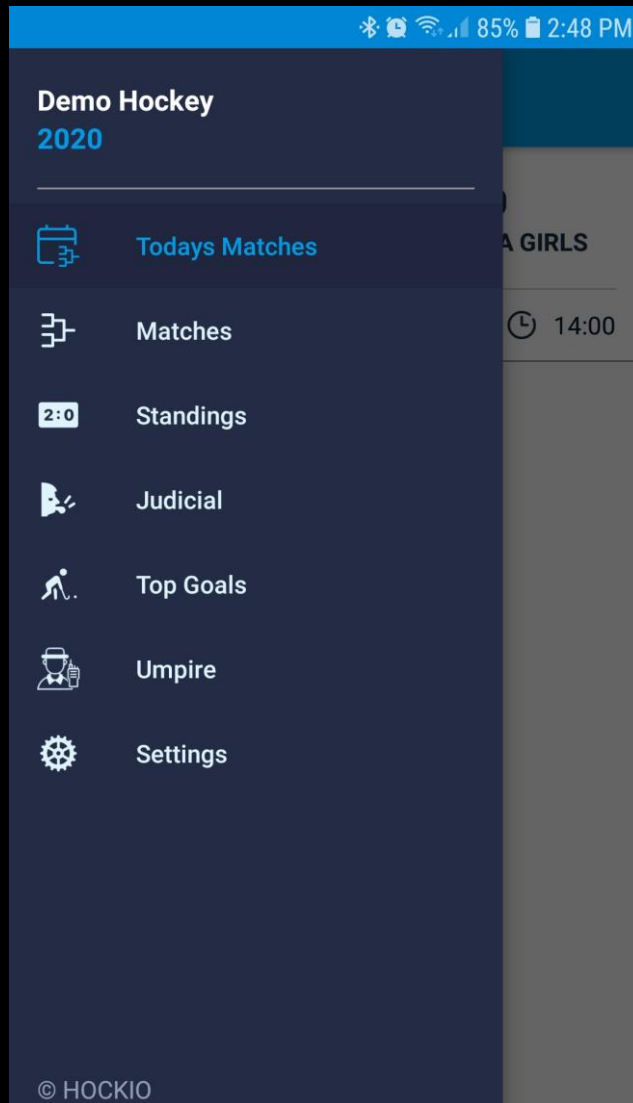

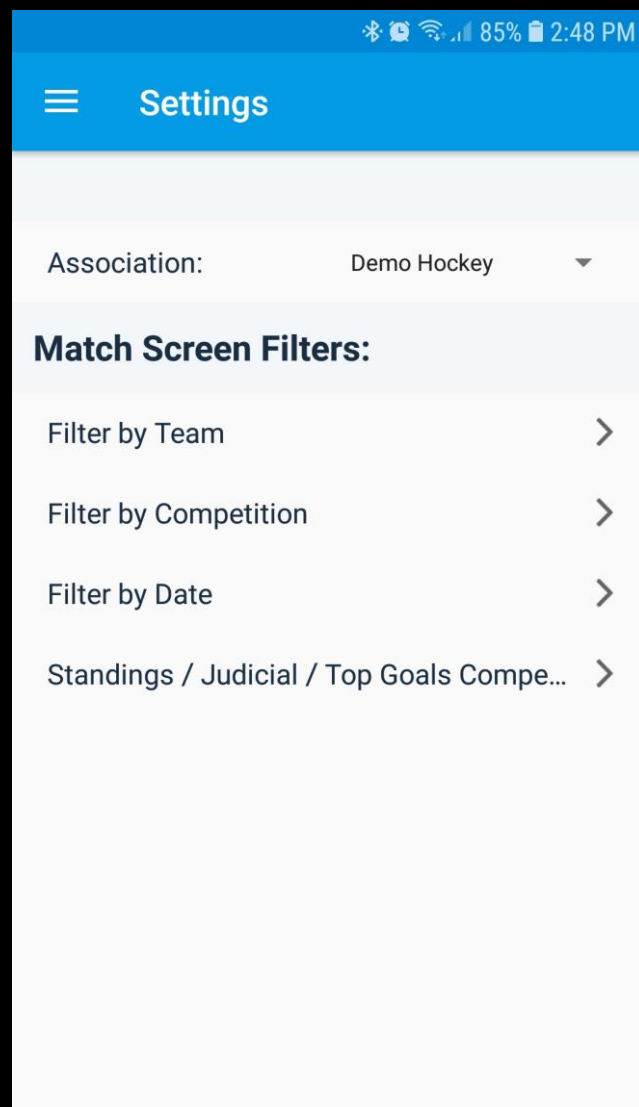


Click on the Menu Icon for options.

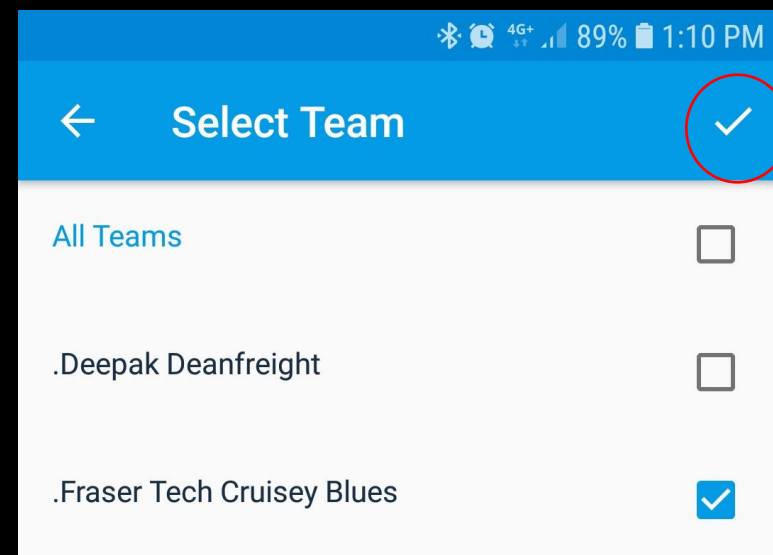

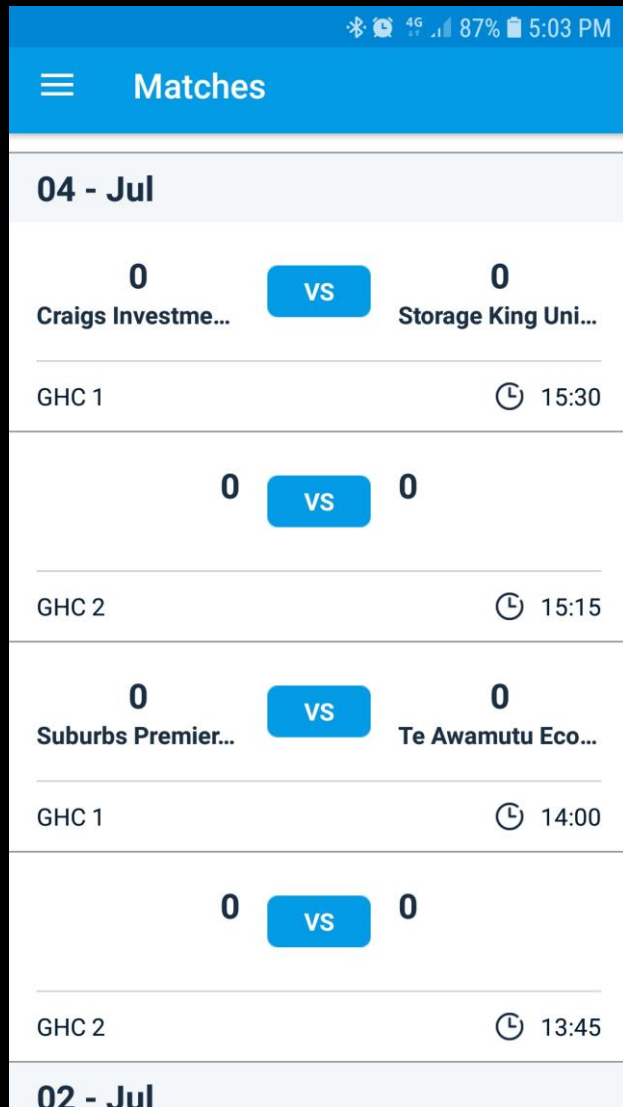
**Team, Competition** > Multiple can be selected.

3 x 15 min. periods

No finals/trophies

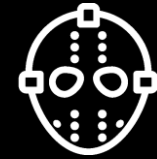

Beginner and Development grades

No goalkeeper can be added

No penalty strokes

Long corners 5m out of top circle

The ball must not be raised above “top of the shin pad” height at any time

A penalty corner should be taken within 30 seconds of being awarded



## Find a foot

Dribbling Skills



Defenders use their stick to stop the ball hitting their foot

Play in pairs. One player has a ball one does not. Points are scored when the attacker can dribble the ball on to the defender's foot.


Ball on the foot is a point  
Ball out is one point for the defender

Smaller / larger field  
Play in teams

## Pass and follow

Passing and receiving



Basic push pass  
Push pass on the run  
Point feet in the direction you want to go

Set up a triangle  
Pass the ball along the first two lengths and run the last length


Dribble to half way and then pass the ball to the next cone.

Have 2 groups racing each other to get all the balls to the other side.

## Possession

Game play



Basic ball carrying  
Basic push pass

Make two teams. The teams play against each other trying to maintain possession for as long as possible.  
Points are scored by completing 5 consecutive passes.

More/ less passes per point  
Two balls at once  
The trainer participates
