## **General Business**

## Mentoring and Training

- P Cawkwell tabled notes on a "Written Evidence Approach" he has taken to support 2 trainee umpires in the absence of any official support programmes. With a number of new/ inexperienced umpires in 2021, it focused attention on the need for mentoring procedures and protocols.
- B Sanders led a discussion on Umpiring Assessment and Progression topics which had been briefly alluded to in a 2020 spread sheet dealing with a range of umpiring issues to be dealt with in the future
- Fortuitously WHA have secured Colin French, Hockey NZ Technical Manager to lead a presentation on mentoring, in Hamilton on Monday 19 April.
- A query regarding aspects of assessing and certifying of umpires is likely to be answered at the 19 April presentation.

# Reimbursements For Umpires

- Reimbursement of Sunday umpires is the responsibility of clubs
- Payment rates are also at the appointing club's discretion
- Mentors may be appointed to umpire with their student

### **Injured Players**

- Players having head injuries -including bleeding or any physical signs of injuries need medical clearances
- Players with clear signs of head impact are to be stood down until ' cleared to play"

# Promoting and Expanding the Umpires' Pool

- The names of the "targeted" development umpires are to be recorded, enabling their future development to be monitored and promoted. (Refer Mentoring and Training above.)
- Their names should also be registered with Ryan or the equivalent official.
