3. Teams will be entered
 - where there are enough(deposit paid) registered players.
4. Where there are not enough
 - we look to combine or
 - include guests or
 - Release players (that registered)
5. Where there are too many a trial will be held with priority given to locals
 - Any that are not selected are released and deposit refunded
