


Waikato Hockey Junior and Senior Divisions

Intermediate Grades

All intermediate hockey is played as half field games. The intention is to focus on player and skill development. Smaller teams means increased involvement and touches of the ball for every player in the game.

Long corners 5m out of top circle

Development and Competitive grades

Penalty corner modifications:

Three defending players to start from opposition circle

Scores kept for grading purposes

Round robin only

Secondary and Senior Grades

All secondary and senior hockey is played on a full field. The intention is to focus on player and skill development outside of premier grades. These grades are played under the standard rules of hockey outlined by the Federation of International Hockey, and the conduct within them is managed under the Hockey New Zealand Code of Conduct.
